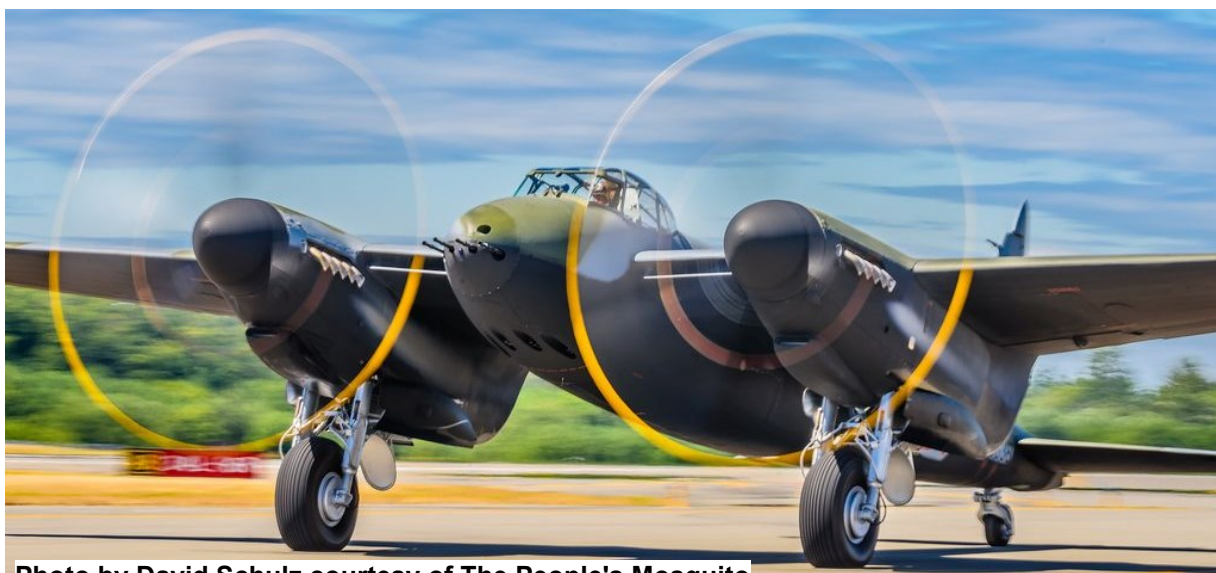

The Wooden Wonder – The De Havilland Mosquito

Presentation by Rod Dean

Rod Dean has been involved in aviation for well over 50 years, both as a serving RAF fighter pilot and latterly as a display pilot. His interest in WW2 aircraft has led him to fly and display many vintage aircraft among them the Spitfire and Mustang.

The Mosquito, 'The Wooden Wonder', was first flown in 1940. Rod will give the history of the development and technical features of the aircraft from its original conception as an unarmed fast bomber, through fighter bomber, night fighter, maritime strike aircraft, photo reconnaissance aircraft and civilian fast transport.
